RETURNING FOOTBALL PLAYERS & CHEERLEADERS (See Below) Freshman Junior Varsity Varsity

Football players returning for a consecutive season with a security deposit roll over, pay only a \$100 re-registration fee.

Cheerleaders returning for a consecutive season with a security deposit roll over pay only a \$50 re-registration fee.

If your 2009 equipment/parent service security deposit was forfeited as a consequence of failing to complete your mandatory parent service hours, you must submit a new security deposit with your registration fee. Refer to your DYFA Parent Handbook for further information. If your uniform or any equipment was not returned, you will need to reimburse the DYFA for all replacement costs before your registration is accepted.

LATE REGISTRATION FEES

Football players and cheerleaders registering after the mandatory parent meetings on August 9 and 10 will be assessed a \$25 late fee.

Football rosters will be officially closed on Saturday, August 21, 2010.

Cheerleading rosters will be officially closed on Wednesday, September 1, 2010

Football players and cheerleaders who *have not* previously participated with the DYFA will receive a one-time late fee exemption.

REGISTRATION ELIGIBILITY RULE

Children who participate in another football or cheerleading program are not eligible to participate in the Downriver Junior Football League if the other program runs concurrently with their participation in the DJFL. This includes middle school football and fall cheerleading programs.

Football Cheerleading Squad: Freshman JV Varsity

The Dearborn Lions "Blue" and "Silver" are two franchises, each with three teams—freshman, jv and varsity—managed by one organization; the Dearborn Youth Football Association. Placement of players and cheerleaders on either "Blue" or "Silver" is based on the geographical location of the child's residence within the city of Dearborn and/or the school he/she attends. Returning participants are given preference through February 28. Open registration begins March 1, with registration conducted on a first-come, first-served basis. For freshman football registration, priority is given to eight- year olds until at least 12 are registered. After that, registration is also on a first-come, first-served basis. If your registration is received after the roster for your child's squad has been filled, your registration form and check will be held and your child's name will be placed on a waiting list. Your check will not be deposited unless space becomes available on the roster at which time, you will be notified. If space does not become available on the roster, your registration form and check will be returned to you. Non-residents are placed on the team (Blue or Silver) that has the lower number of registered players at the time the non-resident registers, providing the appropriate waivers have been obtained. Players and cheerleaders cannot be moved from Silver to Blue or visa versa, as per Downriver Junior Football League rules, unless one has reached capacity and the other still has roster space available, and internal waivers have been granted by both franchise teams. Returning members, please submit this registration form and fee. New members, please submit this registration form and fee, copy of birth certificate, copy of 2009 report card and proof of residency (copy of driver's license, DTE bill or property tax bill only). Once these items are submitted and space is available on the roster for your child, you will receive a follow-up correspondence that provides you with other Downriver Junior Football League-required documents, which must also be submitted to confirm and finalize the registration process. Children are not allowed to participate until the registration process-which includes the purchase of Roaring Raffle tickets is completed. Please submit one payment per child made payable to "DYFA." Returned Checks are subject to a \$25 fee per check.
